- 232135.** No. 248. Dry aspen slope east of Half Moon Lake, Wind River Mountain, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,000 feet. Glaucous plant with narrow spikes; awn divergent.
- 232136.** No. 249. Half Moon Lake, Wind River Mountain, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,000 feet. Multiformity; spikes thick; non-glaucous.
- 232137.** No. 302. Open lodgepole pine woods, 1 mile north of Warm River, Route 191 (Targhee National Forest), Fremont County, Idaho. Plants to 5 feet high; variation in awns, compressed to divergent; spikes to 5 inches long.
- 232138.** No. 306. Open lodgepole pine woods, 9 miles south of West Yellowstone, Route 191, Gallatin County, Montana.
- 232139.** No. 361. Trail east of Mount Alyna and northeast of Swiftcurrent Lake, Appekunny Mountain (Glacier National Park), Glacier County, Montana.
- 232140.** No. 379. Along trail to Grinnell Glacier, Grinnell Mountain (Glacier National Park), Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 7,500 feet. Very fertile grass.
- 232141 to 232151.** *AGROPYRON SUBSECUNDUM* (Link) Hitchc.
Bearded wheatgrass.
- 232141.** No. 105. Aspen grove along stream, Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada. Elevation 7,000 feet. Plants to 3 feet high; heavy seeder.
- 232142.** No. 106. By spring in Aspen grove, Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada. Plants to 3 feet high; not typical.
- 232143.** Rocky, dry, exposed slope, Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada. Plants to 1 foot high.
- 232144.** No. 131. Road to Snow Basin, turn-off at Route 39, Weber County, Utah. Plants to 3 feet high; spikes to 4 inches long; awns long; abundant.
- 232145.** No. 229. Under large lodgepole pine along banks of Green River Lake, Wind River Mountains (Bridger National Forest), Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants to 1.5 feet high; awns long; abundant.
- 232146.** No. 232. Green River Lake, Wind River Mountains (Bridger National Forest), Sublette County, Wyoming. Plant robust.
- 232147.** No. 233. Grassy slope northwest of Green River Lake, Wind River Mountain (Bridger National Forest), Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plant to 2.5 feet high; spikes to 6 inches long.
- 232148.** No. 237. Thicket on north shore, Half Moon Lake, Wind River Mountain, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,000 feet. Awns long.
- 232149.** No. 250. East of Half Moon Lake, Wind River Mountain, Sublette County, Wyoming. Plant with ascending awns; spikes thick.
- 232150.** No. 264. Seven miles northwest of South Pass City, Pine Creek, Fremont County, Wyoming. Plants to 2.5 feet high, typical.
- 232151.** No. 341. Along road in shallow clay, 9 miles north of Augusta, Route 33, Teton County, Montana. Plants few, to 2 feet high; spikes thin; awns long.
