- 232188 to 232191.** *ALOPECURUS AEQUALIS* Sobol. Poaceae. **Shortawn foxtail.**
- 232188.** No. 98. Pasture, Route 11, between Elko and Tuscarora, Elko County, Nevada. Elevation 7,000 feet. Plant 1 foot high.
- 232189.** No. 276. Along edge of Fiddler's Lake, 24 miles southwest of Lander (Wind River Range, near the Continental Divide), Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plant to 6 inches high; vigorous.
- 232190.** No. 462. Moist open banks of French Creek, 9 miles northeast of Fishtrap, road between Anaconda and Wisdom, Deer Lodge County, Montana. Elevation 5,560 feet. Plants to 6 inches high; scarce.
- 232191.** No. 466. Along moist slope 17 miles west of Wisdom, Route 43 (1 mile west of Big Hole Battlefield), Beaverhead County, Montana. Elevation 7,000 feet. Plants scarce.
- 232192.** *ALOPECURUS ALPINUS* J. E. Sm. **Alpine foxtail**
- No. 325. Bear Gulch, Armstrong Ranch, Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 4,900 feet. Plants to 6 feet high; stem stout, glaucous.
- 232193 to 232200.** *BROMUS ANOMALUS* Rupr. Poaceae. **Nodding bromegrass.**
- 232193.** No. 154. Sagebrush pasture 2 miles east of Summit Springs Ranger Station (Ashley National Forest), Daggett County, Utah. Elevation 8,500 feet. Two plants; panicles nodding.
- 232194.** No. 167. Open aspen slope 10 miles west of Trappers Lake, Route 132, White River Valley, Rio Blanco County, Colorado. Plants 2 feet high.
- 232195.** No. 172. Grassy, rocky slope along White River to Trappers Lake, Garfield County, Colorado. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plant to 2 feet high; panicles nodding.
- 232196.** No. 199. Mesa Lake (Grand Mesa), Mesa County, Colorado. Elevation 10,000 feet.
- 232197.** No. 213. Lodgepole pine woods above Lake Green River (Bridger National Forest, Wind River Mountains), Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Typical.
- 232198.** No. 230. Green River Lake (Bridger National Forest, Wind River Mountains), Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants to 2 feet high. Typical.
- 232199.** No. 265. Lodgepole pine woods, 7 miles northwest of Southpass City, along Pine Creek, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 7,200 feet. Plants to 1.5 feet high.
- 232200.** No. 510. On dry slope Yellowstone National Park, 0.5 mile north of Dunraven Pass, Wyoming. Elevation 8,700 feet. Plant 2 feet high.
- 232201 to 232206.** *BROMUS CARINATUS* Hook. & Arn. **Mountain bromegrass.**
- 232201.** No. 13. Moist spot under redwood trees, Mount Tamalpais, Panoramic Highway, Steep Ravine, Marin County, California.
- 232202.** No. 14. Inverness Park, Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, Inverness Park, Marin County, California.
- 232203.** No. 16. Road to Point Reyes, 4 miles west of Inverness Park, Marin County, California.
- 232204.** No. 31. Arid sagebrush slope, Beckwourth, east side of Beckwourth School, Plumas County, California. Elevation 4,945. Clumps to 3 feet high, scattered.
- 232205.** No. 33. Grassy roadside, Fort Creek Motel, 3 miles south of Fort Klamath, Route 62, Klamath County, Oregon. Elevation 5,500 feet. Plants to 1.5 feet high, abundant.
- 232206.** No. 200. Mesa Lake (Grand Mesa), Mesa County, Colorado. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plant 3 feet high.
