- 232207 to 232216.** *BROMUS CILIATUS* L. **Fringed brome grass.**
- 232207.** No. 201. Rocky slope above Lost Lake draining into Mesa Lake (Grand Mesa), Mesa County, Colorado. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plant drooping; panicle purplish tinged.
- 232208.** No. 408. Meadow, Glacier National Park, Belly River, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 4,700 feet.
- 232209.** No. 410. Two miles south of Canadian border, Glacier National Park, Belly River, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 4,700 feet. Plant robust, 4 feet high.
- 232210.** No. 412. Along stream, Glacier National Park, Belly River, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 4,800 feet. Plant 2 feet high; spikelets delicate.
- 232211.** No. 426. Shaded habitat, Glacier National Park, Baring Falls, Flathead County, Montana. Elevation 4,500 feet. Plants 1 foot high; spikelets pendulous.
- 232212.** No. 443. One-tenth mile south of Camas Creek, Glacier National Park, North Fork Road, Flathead County, Montana.
- 232213.** No. 444. Along trail to Rogers Lake, Glacier National Park, Camas Creek Valley, Flathead County, Montana.
- 232214.** No. 505. Shore of Yellowstone Lake, Bay Bridge, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming. Elevation 6,700 feet.
- 232215.** No. 513. Dry slope in lodgepole pine woods, Yellowstone National Park, 3.8 miles west of Tower Junction, road to Mammoth Hot Springs, Wyoming. Plant 1.5 feet high; shade type.
- 232216.** No. 521. Moist slope, Route 12, 1 mile southwest of Beartooth Lake, Park County, Wyoming. Plant 2 feet high; panicles nodding.
- 232217 and 232218.** *BROMUS INERMIS* Leyss. **Smooth brome grass.**
- 232217.** No. 133. Arid slope in scrub oak zone, 3.5 miles off Route 39, Snow Basin, Weber County, Utah. Plant 3 feet high; leaves 0.75 inch wide; panicles drooping.
- 232218.** No. 134. Arid slope in scrub oak zone, 3.5 miles off Route 39, Snow Basin, Weber County, Utah. Plants mostly sterile; panicles upright.
- 232219.** *BROMUS LAEVIPIES* Shear **Chinook brome grass.**
No. 8. Mat Davis Trail, Mount Tamalpais, Boot Jack Camp, Marin Co., California.
- 232220 to 232240.** *BROMUS MARGINATUS* Nees **Soft brome grass.**
- 232220.** No. 21. Gravel bank under pines, Donner Lake, Route 40, Nevada County, California. Elevation 6,000 feet.
- 232221.** No. 22. Along shore of Lake Tahoe, Placer County, California. Early maturing clumps.
- 232222.** No. 24. Lake Tahoe, Route 28, Placer County, California.
- 232223.** No. 41. South entrance Roger River National Forest, Route 62, Klamath County, Oregon.
- 232224.** No. 70. Twelve miles northeast of White Bird, Route 95, Idaho County, Idaho. Spikelets pubescent; may be resistant to smut and ergot.
- 232225.** No. 75. Cold Spring Lookout near Seven Devils Mountain, 12 miles northwest of Riggins, Idaho County, Idaho. Elevation 6,920 feet. Plants 2 feet high; heavy seeder; head characteristics diversified.
- 232226.** No. 87. Along the Little Salmon River, 3 miles south of Pollock, Route 95, Idaho County, Idaho.
- 232227.** No. 90. Pasture along Little Salmon Creek, 6 miles south of Pollock, Idaho County, Idaho. Plant pubescent.
