- 232285.** No. 102. Three miles west of meadow, foot of Ruby Mountains, road between Elko and Lamoille Canyon, Elko County, Nevada. Plant 4 feet high.
- 232286.** *FESTUCA CALIFORNICA* Vasey Poaceae. **California fescue.**
No. 4. Dry slope, Boot Jack Camp, Mat Davis Trail, Mount Tamalpais, Marin County, California. Plants to 4 feet high; heavy seeder.
- 232287.** *FESTUCA ELATIOR* L. Poaceae. **Meadow fescue.**
No. 92. Three miles south of Pollock, Route 95, Idaho County, Idaho.
- 232288 to 232295.** *FESTUCA IDAHOENSIS* Elmer **Idaho fescue.**
- 232288.** No. 40. Dry, gravel soil, entrance to Rogue River National Forest, Route 62, Klamath County, Oregon.
- 232289.** No. 72. Gravel clearing 12 miles northeast of White Bird, Route 95, Idaho County, Idaho. Elevation 4,500 feet. Isolated clump, 3 feet high; very heavy seeder.
- 232290.** No. 76. Cold Springs Lookout, 12 miles northwest of Riggins near Seven Devils Mountain, Idaho County, Idaho. Elevation 6,900 feet. Plant 3 feet high.
- 232291.** No. 185. Nineteen miles north of New Castle on the Buford Road, Garfield County, Colorado.
- 232292.** No. 224. Meadow among groves of lodgepole pines, Bridger National Forest, Green River Lake, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants cespitose.
- 232293.** No. 278. Exposed slope above Fiddlers Lake, 20 miles southwest of Lander (Wind River Range), Fremont County, Wyoming. Plants to 12 inches high; leaves thin, glaucous; spikes green or glaucous; very poor seeder.
- 232294.** No. 279. High slope, Fiddlers Lake, 20 miles southwest of Lander (Wind River Range), Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plants to 1.5 feet high; spikes and stems purplish; leaves glaucous; good seeder.
- 232295.** No. 516. Dry, rocky, open, lodgepole pine slope, Yellowstone National Park, 9 miles west of Tower Junction, Mammoth Hot Springs Road.
- 232296.** *FESTUCA OVINA* var. *BRACHYPHYLLA* (Schult.) Piper **Fescue.**
No. 148. Among lodgepole and yellow pine, road between South Fork and Middle Fork of Carter Creek (east of Sheep Creek Park, Ashley National Forest), Daggett County, Utah. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants to 6 inches high.
- 232297.** *FESTUCA SCABRELLA* Torr. **Rough fescue.**
No. 320. Dry lodgepole hillside, Stemple Pass (Helena National Forest), Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 6,300 feet. Large clumps, to 3.5 feet high.
- 232298.** *FESTUCA SUBULATA* Trin. **Bearded fescue.**
No. 395. Moist flat of spruce and fir trees, Glacier National Park, Piegan Park, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 4,900 feet. Plants to 1.5 feet high; spikelets reflexed.
- 232299 to 232303.** *FESTUCA THURBERI* Vasey. **Fescue.**
- 232299.** No. 166. Open aspen slope, 10 miles west of Trappers Lake (White River Valley), Rio Blanco County, Colorado. Elevation 7,500 feet.
- 232300.** No. 175. Trappers Lake, Garfield County, Colorado. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plants to 3 feet high, abundant.
