- 232340.** No. 256. Dry wash in sagebrush plains, 7 miles north of Farson, Route 187, Sweetwater County, Wyoming. Elevation 6,500 feet. Plant 8 inches high; abundant; seeds black, small.
- 232341.** No. 308. Eighteen miles south of Cameron, Route 1, Madison County, Montana. Plant large; seeds black.
- 232342.** No. 474. Along eroded bank, 30 miles southeast of Jackson, Beaverhead County, Montana. Elevation 7,000 feet. Small seed type; seeds black; heavily grazed by stock.
- 232343.** No. 484. Eroded rhyolite slope, Yellowstone National Park, Norris Basin Road, 1 mile south of Mammoth Hot Springs, Wyoming. Small seed type.
- 232344.** No. 515. Scattered on open, eroded, slope, 8 miles west of Tower Junction, Yellowstone National Park. Seeds large.
- 232345.** *PHLEUM ALPINUM* L. Poaceae. **Alpine timothy.**
No. 528. Tundra, five miles north of Beartooth Lake, Route 12, Park County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,700.
- 232346.** *POA AMPLA* Merr. Poaceae. **Big bluegrass.**
No. 219. Sagebrush meadow along lodgepole pine woods, Green River Lake, Sublette County, Wyoming. Plants to 3 feet high, abundant; heavy seeder.
- 232347.** *POA CANBYI* (Scribn.) Piper **Bluegrass.**
No. 316. Stemple Pass (Helena National Forest), Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 6,400 feet. Plant 1.5 feet high.
- 232348.** *POA JUNCIFOLIA* Scribn. **Bluegrass.**
No. 221. Sagebrush meadow along lodgepole pine woods, Green River Lake, (Bridger National Forest, Wind River Mountain), Sublette County, Wyoming. Plant 1.5 feet high.
- 232349.** *POA NERVOSA* (Hook.) Vasey **Bluegrass.**
No. 53. Dry pumice hillside, Crater Lake National Park, Vidua Falls, Klamath County, Oregon. Elevation 6,100 feet. Plant to 1.5 feet high.
- 232350.** *POA NEVADENSIS* Vasey ex Scribn. **Nevada bluegrass.**
No. 99. Arid pasture along Route 11, between Elko and Tuscorora, Elko County, Nevada. Elevation 7,000 feet. Plant to 2.5 feet high, dense, pure stand covering several acres.
- 232351.** *POA PALUSTRIS* L. **Bluegrass.**
No. 317. Dry lodgepole pine, Stemple Pass (Helena National Forest), Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 6,300.
- 232352.** *POA NERVOSA* (Hook.) Vasey **Bluegrass.**
No. 280. Lodgepole pine on dry granite slope, Fiddlers Lake, 24 miles southwest of Lander (Wind River Range near the Continental Divide), Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,000 feet. Plant 1 foot high; spikes drooping.
- 232353.** *SITANION HYSTRIX* (Nutt.) J. G. Smith Poaceae. **Bottlebrush squirreltail.**
No. 157. Between Elk Creek and Little Elk Creek (Ashley National Forest), Daggett County, Utah. Plant 2 feet high; awns long.
- 232354.** *STIPA CALIFORNICA* Merr. & Davy Poaceae. **Pacific needlegrass.**
No. 58. Crater Lake National Park, front of Ranger Headquarters, Klamath County, Oregon. Elevation 6,400 feet. Plants abundant.
