✕ **235304.** *ALSOPHILA HANCOCKII* Nakai Polypodiaceae.

Col. No. 500. In damp woods near Cape Ashizuri, Nakamura, Shikoku. Evergreen fern; fronds finely divided.

✕ ✕ **235305.** *ANGIOPTERIS SUBOPPOSITIFOLIA* de Vries Marrattiaceae.

Col. No. 507. In damp woods, Ashizuri-zaki, Nakamura, Shikoku. Large evergreen fern; frond supra-decompound, 9 feet long.

✕ **235306.** *PEUCEDANUM JAPONICUM* Thunb. Apiaceae.

Col. No. 502. On sea cliffs, in full sun. Ashizuri-zaki. Perennial; leaves ternately compound, to 18 inches long; flowers white, in compound head. Frequently used in flower arrangements.

**235307.** *ARDISIA SIEBOLDII* Miq. Myrsinaceae.

Col. No. 506. In deep shady forest glen, Ashizuri-zaki. Shrub evergreen to 3 feet; leaves elliptic, serrate; flowers white; fruits red.

**235308.** *ARDISIA FUSILLA* A. DC.

Col. No. 536. In damp woods of Shrine Forest, Shirahama, Wakayama-ken. Small, wild, prostrate evergreen; stem rooting; leaves ovate, serrate, dark green. Possibly a good ground cover.

**235309.** *ARISAEMA* sp. Araceae.

Col. No. 560. In damp woods, along streambed, Gegu Shrine Forest, Ise City, Mie Prefecture, Wild, herbaceous perennial; leaflets broadly lanceolate; fruits red.

**235310.** *ASARUM* sp. Aristolochiaceae.

Col. No. 542. Along mountain path, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama-ken. Herbaceous perennial; leaves green, heart shaped.

**235311.** *ASARUM* sp.

Col. No. 557. In damp woods, Gegu Shrine Forest, Ise City, Mie Prefecture. Wild, herbaceous perennial; leaves longly ovate, cordate, variegated gray green.

**235312.** *ASPLENIUM WRIGHTII* Eat. Polypodiaceae.

Col. No. 540. In damp woods of mountain forest, Nachi-san, Kii, Wakayama-ken. Large evergreen fern; leaves pinnate, dark shining.

**235313.** *BAUHINIA JAPONICA* Maxim. Caesalpiniaceae.

Col. No. 523. Koshima Island, Tanabe Bay, Kii, Wakayama. Wild deciduous liana at northern limit; leaves ovate, sometimes deeply lobed; flowers not seen.

**235314.** *CAMELLIA JAPONICA* L. Theaceae. **Common camellia.**

Col. No. 534. In Kyoto University Experiment Forest, Oshima Island, Kushimoto, Wakayama. 'Shiro-tama'. Early variety; flowers large, double, cupshaped; color pink.
