**236481.** *LATHYRUS LATIFOLIUS* L. Fabaceae. **Perennial peavine.**  
Originally from the Netherlands; comparable to the 'Wagner Flat'.

**236482.** *PHALARIS AQUATICA* L. Poaceae. **Large canarygrass.**  
'Gb-81'. Grazing type, low, small stems. Originally from the Waite Agricultural Research Institute, Adelaide, South Australia.

**236483.** *TRIFOLIUM INCARNATUM* L. Fabaceae. **Crimson clover.**  
Seeds white; flowers white, late. Originally from Bretigny-sur-Orge, France.

**236484.** *TRIFOLIUM FRAGIFERUM* L. **Strawberry clover.**  
'Cohuna' or 'Swan Hill'. More vigorous than commercial types. Originally from the Arthur Yates Company, Sydney, Australia.
