Col. No. 31. Dense woods near the public campgrounds, Golden, British Columbia. Elevation 2,570 feet.
- 236661.** ACTAEA RUBRA (Ait.) Willd. Ranunculaceae. **Red baneberry.**  
Col. No. 187. Banff National Park, 4.5 miles west of Banff. Elevation 4,600 feet.
- 236662.** ACTAEA RUBRA f. NEGLECTA (Gillman) Robins **Baneberry.**  
Col. No. 271. Along Sturgeon Lake, 3 miles west of Calala.
- 236663 to 236667.** AGROPYRON DASYSTACHYUM (Hook.) Scribn. Poaceae. **Thickspike wheatgrass.**
- 236663.** Col. No. 115. Plains along Waterton Lake National Park. Plant 2 feet high; glaucous.
- 236664.** Col. No. 280. Arid slopes above the shelf of Peace River near Dunvegan. Elevation 2,200 feet. Plant 2.5 feet high; glaucous.
- 236665.** Col. No. 288. Shelf overlooking the Peace River, 2 miles south of the town, Peace River.
- 236666.** Col. No. 319. Sand dunes, 17 miles north of Jasper, Route 16. Some fertile florets.
- 236667.** Col. No. 331. Two miles east of Fort Saskatchewan.
- 236668 to 236672.** AGROPYRON INERME (Scribn. & Sm.) Rydb. **Beardless wheatgrass.**
- 236668.** Col. No. 19. Sandy loam valley 2 miles north of Kimberly, British Columbia. Elevation 2,700 feet. Plant 2 feet high; awnless.
- 236669.** Col. No. 77. Arid slope 1 mile south of Ainsworth, British Columbia. Plant 4 feet high; spikes narrow, 8 inches long.
- 236670.** Col. No. 78. Arid, rocky slope, 1 mile south of Slochan, British Columbia.
- 236671.** Col. No. 79. One mile south of Boswell, British Columbia.
- 236672.** Col. No. 96. Dry slope associated with douglas-fir and yellow pine, St. Mary's Lake Road, British Columbia, 3 miles west of Route 95. Plant 3.5 feet high; awnless.
- 236673 to 236675.** AGROPYRON LATIGLUME (Scribn. & Sm. Rydb. **Wheatgrass.**
- 236673.** Col. No. 158. Sentinel Peak, Coleman-Kananaskis Road. Elevation 7,785 feet. Plant 1 foot high; spikes robust.
- 236674.** Col. No. 298. Along McLeod Road, 4.5 miles south of Cadomin.
- 236675.** Col. No. 315. Route 16, 12 miles north of Jasper.
- 236676.** AGROPYRON PSEUDOREPENS Scribn. & Sm. **Wheatgrass.**  
Col. No. 192. Eroded bank along the Bow River, 1 mile west of Banff. Elevation 4,585 feet. Plant 4 feet high; spikes to 8 inches long.
- 236677 and 236678.** AGROPYRON SMITHII Rydb. **Western wheatgrass.**
- 236677.** Col. No. 24. Along the Kickinghorse River, Golden, British Columbia. Elevation 2,570 feet. Plants 4 feet high; spikes 6 inches long; very robust.
- 236678.** Col. No. 116. Plains along Waterton Lake.
