**236964.** Col. No. 92. Dry rocky plains associated with yellow pine, larch and spruce, 3 miles northwest of Cranbrook, British Columbia. Plant 3 feet high.

**236965.** Col. No. 97. Three miles west of Route 95 on St. Mary's Lake Road, British Columbia.

**236966.** Col. No. 100. Along Fairy Creek, 1 mile west of Fernie, British Columbia. Plant 3 feet high, drooping.

**236967.** Col. No. 129. Opening in lodgepole pine woods, 4 miles north of Coleman, Coleman-Kananaskis Road. Plant 3 feet high.

**236968. STIPA COMATA var. INTERMEDIA** Scribn. & Tweedy **Needlegrass.**

Col. No. 48. Burned over parkland meadow, road to the Dominion Experiment Plots, Pass Lake, British Columbia, 10 miles north of Kamloops. Pure stand; plants 2 feet high.

**236969. STIPA LETTERMANII** Vasey **Needlegrass.**

Col. No. 98. Open parkland, 5 miles southeast of Rapport, British Columbia. Plant 2 feet high, spreading; spikes usually sheathed by blades; awns 3 inches long, curled.

**236970 to 236973. STIPA RICHARDSONII** Link **Needlegrass.**

**236970.** Col. No. 22. Open Douglas-fir woods along Toby Creek, 6 miles west of Wilmer, British Columbia. Elevation 3,100 feet. Plant 2.5 feet high; outstanding vegetative growth; good bunch.

**236971.** Col. No. 91. Three miles northwest of Cranbrook, British Columbia. Plant 4 feet high; large.

**236972.** Col. No. 99. Open yellow pine parkland, 5 miles southeast of Rapport, British Columbia.

**236973.** Col. No. 145. Open dry field, Racehorse Creek Camp, Coleman-Kananaskis Road. Plant 3 feet high.

**236974 and 236975. STIPA VIRIDULA** Trin. **Green needlegrass.**

**236974.** Col. No. 216. Sandy shelf overlooking the Ghost River, 11 miles west of Cochrane.

**236975.** Col. No. 279. Along shelf of Peace River near Dunvegan. Plant 3 feet high, spreading; clumps large.

**236976. VACCINIUM CAESPITOSUM** Michx. **Vacciniaceae. Blueberry.**

Col. No. 220. Lodgepole pine woods, Clearwater Forest, boundary campgrounds, 12 miles east of Nordegg. Plant 3 feet high; prolific fruiter.

**236977. VACCINIUM MEMBRANACEUM** Dougl. **Blueberry.**

Col. No. 73. Sandy bank along the Kuskonook Creek, 2 miles north of Nakusp, British Columbia. Elevation 1,400 feet. Plant 3.5 feet high; fruits 0.75 inch in diameter, very juicy.

**236978 to 236982. VACCINIUM MYRTILLOIDES** Michx. **Blueberry.**

**236978.** Col. No. 43. Opening along Yard Creek, Eagle Pass, British Columbia. Elevation 1,500 feet.

**236979.** Col. No. 71. Sandy bank along Kuskonook Creek, 2 miles north of Nakusp, British Columbia. Elevation 1,400 feet. Bushes 3 feet high; fruits 0.5 inch in diameter; yield heavy.

**236980.** Col. No. 255. Sandy soil, 2 miles east of Smith. Plant 4 feet high.

**236981.** Col. No. 264. Sphagnum bog along Lesser Slave Lake, 5 miles west of Joussard. Plant 5 feet high.

**236982.** Col. No. 293. Thirty-six miles northwest of Whitecourt. Plant 8 feet high; fruits very large, clustered; ripening period very short; possible commercial value.
