Ogden Col. No. 51177. Tecolotlan near road from Cocula to Tecolotlan, Jalisco. Stem short; leaves blue-green, slightly glaucous, to 1.1 meters long; inflorescence to 4.5 meters high.

246023. *AGAVE CUPREATA* Trel.

Col. No. 10476. From Barrancas. Plant multileaved, inflexed, forming balled rosettes; panicle 8 meters high; flowers yellow.

246024. *AGAVE GOLDMANIANA* Trel.

Col. No. 10355. South of Tinaja Yubai, Idria-Cardon Forest. Plant large caulescent to 1.5 meters high; leaves green; flowers yellow.

246025. *AGAVE LOPHANTHA* Schiede **Crested agave.**

Ogden Col. No. 51111. Road over Sierra Madre to Jaumave, Tamaulipas. Acaulescent; inflorescence spicate, to 5 meters high.

Col. No. 12294. Lagunilla, northwest of Pachuca, Hidalgo. Plant large, maguey; leaves long; panicle 8 meters high, laterals long.

246027. *AGAVE* sp.

Ogden Col. No. 51199. Six meters north of Pitayo along highway between Acatlan and Izucar de Matamoros. Plant acaulescent; leaves blue-green to gray-green, glaucous, to 1 meter long.
