

249786. 'Harlequin'. Leaf center green, edge turning cream, the whole splashed with red and brown. A sport of 'Paisley Shawl'.
249787. 'Laing's Croton'. Leaves narrow, color patterns minute varying from cream to red.
249788. 'Lord Falmouth'. Plant bushy; leaves small, green, veined brown, pink center.
249789. 'Moonbeam'. Leaves light yellow-green, turning cream; edge frilled.
249790. 'Paisley Shawl'. Leaf center green, stippled brown; edge turning cream, stippled with red. Unusual.
249791. 'Pegasus'.
249792. 'Picturatum'. Plant bushy; leaves small, brown-black with red centers.
249793. 'Pineapple Beauty'. Leaves yellow-green, turning gold with reddish-brown blotches.
249794. 'Poynton'. Plant vigorous; leaf edge dark green splashed with brown, center creamy white splashed with bright red.
249795. 'Red Croton'. Plant; leaves small, narrow, with red centers edged brown.
249796. 'Rust'. Plant has open habit; leaves large, crinkly orange-brown.
249797. 'Russet'. Leaves golden-brown with pink center, pale green edge.
249798. 'Salmon Croton'. Plant medium size, bushy; leaves long, narrow, brown with salmon-pink center.
249799. 'Skylark'. Leaves light green stippled with light brown.
249800. 'Sunbeam'. Leaves light green later turning yellow.
249801. 'Sunburst'. Leaves light yellow-green, splashed with brown and red.
249802. 'Sunset'. Plant of medium vigor; leaves medium sized, golden brown.
249803. 'Tapestry'. Plant vigorous; leaves brown with frilled edge, later turning bright red.
249804. 'Torch'. Leaves outstanding bright red.
249805. 'Twinkle'.
249806. 'Vesuvius'. Plant vigorous; leaves brown turning to bright brick-red.
249807. 'White Gem'. Leaves large, white stippled with green around the edge.
