Collected July to September 1957, in Arizona unless otherwise indicated.

254442. Col. No. 7663. Coarse rocky soil. Elevation 2,500 feet. A mixed collection made in 1946.
 254443. Col. No. 16470. Gravel slope. Elevation 2,000 feet. Shrub large with spreading 'white' branches; capsules long pointed, few two- or three-fascicled; seeds large, not bitter.
 254444. Col. No. 16471. Gravel slope. Elevation 2,900 feet. Shrub symmetrical; seeds not bitter.
 254445. Col. No. 16794. Gravel slope. Elevation 2,600 feet. Spreading shrub to three feet high; capsules long-pedunculate, more than 50 percent are three- to six-fasciculate, one- to two-seeded. The seed size and peduncle length are desirable characters and the progeny should be screened.
 254446. Col. No. 16795. Gravel slope. Tall shrub with shoots to six feet long; flowers at every node; flowering prolific.
 254447. Col. No. 16976. Gravel slope. Elevation 2,600 feet. Shrub to three feet high, open habit.
 254448. Col. No. 16797. Gravel slope. Elevation 2,600 feet. Low-branched shrub to three feet high; capsules long-pedunculate, large, thick with single large seed. The low habit and large seeds suggest its progeny be tested for these characters and suitability to culture.
 254449. Col. No. 16798. Gravel slope. Elevation 2,600 feet. Large, leafy shrub with long shoots; flowers at every node. Plant should be studied for yield possibilities.
 254450. Col. No. 16799. Elevation 2,600 feet. Spreading bush to four feet high; capsules long; seeds long; wax content of seed 45.1%.
 254451. Col. No. 16800. Gravel slope. Elevation 2,600 feet. Vigorous shrub to six feet high; shoots long; seeds large, yield light. Of interest for its tall vigorous habit.
 254452. Col. No. 16801. Rocky slope. Elevation 2,600 feet. Large, heavy yielding shrub; capsules medium-size, ovoid; seeds single, oblong.
