**293706.** 'Purple Cushion' (Tested as No. 688). From cross of ('Kaempferi' × 'Snow') × ('Kaempferi' × 'Snow'). Plant very dwarf, about 2 times as wide as high; branches dense, covered with persistent dark-green foliage; flowers single, cyclamen purple, about 1.5 inches across, profuse.

**293707.** 'Flower Girl' (Tested as No. 689). From cross of ('Kaempferi' × 'Snow') × ('Kaempferi' × 'Snow'). Plant very dwarf, about 2.5 times as wide as high; branches dense, covered with semipersistent, medium-green leaves; flowers single, dark pink, about 1.75 inches across, profuse.

**293708 to 293748. BETA VULGARIS L. Chenopodiaceae. Beet.**
