

**306801. CAMELLIA SINENSIS (L.) Kuntze Theaceae. Tea**

From Viet Nam. Seeds presented by Robert Knoernschild, United States Agency for International Development, Saigon. Received July 13, 1965.

'Shan'. Tran Ninh area of Laos, Xien Quang Province, plantation near Bao Loc (Bla) in central highlands of Vietnam.

**306802 to 306807.**

From Costa Rica, Guatemala and Honduras. Plants collected by H. S. Gentry, agricultural explorer, Crops Research Division, Beltsville, Md. Numbered July 14, 1965.

**306802. AGAVE sp. Amaryllidaceae.**

Col. No. 20664. Lankester Botanic Garden near Paraiso, Costa Rica. Elevation 4,000 feet. Plant medium size, compact. Leaves dark green, broad, plane, margins crenate, apex short acuminate. Plants about 5 years old, grown from bulbils of single plants.

**306803. AGAVE sp.**

Col. No. 20665. Lankester Botanic Garden near Paraiso, Costa Rica. Elevation 4,000 feet. Plant medium size, light glaucous gray, open rosettes 3 feet or more high. Leaves slender, S-curving with small proximal teeth and long acuminate tip.

**306804. AGAVE sp.**

Col. No. 20668. Rio Segundo northwest of San Jose, Costa Rica. Elevation 4,000 feet. Small rosettes from freely branching, slender stem. Leaves thin, brittle, plane to recurved conduplicate, dark green; small, pale distal teeth; short, acuminate spine, small.

**306805. AGAVE SAMALANA Trel.**

Col. No. 20815. 'Gi'. Roadside on volcanic rocky slope above Zunil, Guatemala. Elevation 7,000-7,500 feet. Medium to large, glaucous light green, single rosettes with outcurving leaves with variable teeth. Inflorescence to 25 feet high, thick, narrow panicle with 30-40 laterals in upper half of thick shaft. Flowers light yellow, tightly spaced in ball form.

**306806. AGAVE sp.**

Col. No. 21026. Mountain grade south of Cunen, Departamento Quiche, Guatemala. Elevation 6,500-7,000 feet. Plant clustering with basal offsets, dark to light green, medium-size rosettes on rocks. Leaves rigid, variable in size and armature; one old spike about 6 feet long, slender.

**306807. AGAVE LETONAE Trel.**

Col. No. 20694. Cayoles, Departamento Yoro, Honduras. Elevation 1,500 feet. Large radial green rosettes said to be 27 years old. Panicles to 25 feet high with 20-30 laterals, broad, open. Flowers greenish yellow.

**306808. PRUNUS CERASUS var. SEMPERFLORENS (Ehrh.) Koch Rosaceae.**

From Great Britain. Budsticks presented by Hillier and Sons, Winchester, England. Received July 21, 1965.

**306809. AVENA SATIVA L. Gramineae. Common oat.**

From Great Britain. Seeds presented by J. D. Hayes, Aberystwyth, Wales, through C. W. Roane, Virginia Polytechnic Institute, Blacksburg, Virginia. Received July 14, 1965.

**306810. DAUCUS CAROTA L. Umbelliferae. Carrot.**

From New Zealand. Seeds presented by F. Cooper, Limited, Wellington through F. G. Robinson, Limited, Papanui, Christchurch. Received July 14, 1965.
