309891. Col. No. 20813. Fruits small, irregular, soft, red, mixed types. Grown by Indians.

Market in Chichicastenango, Quiche Department. Elevation 7,000. Grown by Indians.

309892. Col. No. 20837. Fruit small, red.

309893. Col. No. 20838. Fruit small, red.

309894. Col. No. 20839. Fruit small, oblong, 2 inches long, ripening red.

309895. Col. No. 20840. Fruit small, depressed with creases.

309896. Col. No. 20841. Fruit round to depressed, varying sizes, juicy, red, some with purplish lustre.

Market in Solola. Elevation 7,500 feet. Grown by Indians.

309897. Col. No. 20870. Fruit small, ribbed, red.

309898. Col. No. 20871. Fruit small, depressed, 1½ inches diameter.

309899. Col. No. 20888. 'Tomate ciruela'. Market in Barberena, Santa Rosa Department. Elevation 3,000 feet. Fruit small, oblong, paste type, said to be disease resistant.

309900. Col. No. 20907. 'Tomate'. Market in Progreso, Jutiapa Department. Elevation 3,000 feet. Fruit small, ovoid, pink, grown locally.

Market in Jalapa. Elevation 4,300 feet.

309901. Col. No. 20937. 'Tomate'. Fruit small, depressed, ribbed, 1½ inches diameter, bright red. Grown locally.

309902. Col. No. 20938. 'Tomate ciruela'. Fruit small, ovoid angular, 1 by 1¾ inches, pink and orange red.

309903. Col. No. 20939. 'Tomate'. Fruit ovoid angular, oblong, paste type, to 2¼ inches long, orange red.

309904. Col. No. 20940. Fruit depressed round, to two inches diameter, bright red. Grown locally at San Pedro Pinula.

309905. Col. No. 20941. Fruit small, depressed round, thin skin, juicy. Grown at Asuncionita.

309906. Col. No. 20942. Fruit small, size and shape variable, red. Grown at Santa Rosa.

309907. Col. No. 20946. 'Tomatillo'. Market in San Luis, Jalapa Department. Elevation 2,500 feet. Fruit small, round, drought resistant, spontaneous. Said to be disease resistant.

Market in Ipala, Chiquimula Department. Elevation 2,000 feet.

309908. Col. No. 20947. 'Chibe de Ipala'. Fruit medium sized, oblong to ovoid, orange red to pink, 1 by 2 inches.

309909. Col. No. 20948. 'Tomate ciruela'. Fruit oblong, firm, orange red. Said to have resistance to several diseases.

309910. Col. No. 20949. 'Tomate cumba'. Fruit small, ovoid to oblong, 1¾ inches long, pointed tips, orange red.

309911. Col. No. 20950. 'Tomate cumba'. Fruit pear shaped, 2 inches long, bright pink.

309912. Col. No. 20951. 'Tomate ciruela'. Fruit medium sized, oblong, 2 inches long by 1½ inches, rind thick, red. Grown in Teculután.

Market in Chiquimula. Elevation 1,000 feet.

309913. Col. No. 20956. Fruit small, round, depressed, thin skins, red.

309914. Col. No. 20957. Fruit about 3 inches long, pink; no seed in narrowed fleshy base.
