**377736 and 377737. PHASEOLUS VULGARIS L. Leguminosae. Common bean.**

From Netherlands. Seed presented by N. Hubbeling, Institute for Phytopathological Investigations, Wageningen. Received January 8, 1973.

377736. 'Dubbele Witte'. Stringless, dwarf snap. First white-seeded snap bean selected about 50 years ago. Productive, good flavor. Some resistance to halo blight, good field tolerance to races 1 and 2 of *Pseudomonas phaseolicola*.

377737. 'Rona'. Selected 1953 by R. Krijger, Kloetinge and released in 1962. Parent was 'Walcherse Witte' grown for years on Walcheren Island, mild climate. White-seeded, dry shell bean. Good resistance to halo blight but rather susceptible to common bean mosaic. Also susceptible to anthracnose races alpha and delta.
