380607. 251. Kamalabad. Perennial to 20 cm. Yellow blooms. Sod former. Potential ground cover. Wild.
380608. 340. Nujian, Dez Watershed Camp 50 km. north of Khorramabad, Loristan Province. Perennial to 25 cm. tall, yellow blooms. Sod former. Dry site. Wild.
380609. *ACHILLEA SULPHUREA* Boiss.  
289. Seritchal. Perennial to 20 cm. tall. Yellow blooms. Sod former. Thick grayish finely divided leaf. Wild.
380610. *ACHILLEA* sp.  
218. Eighteen km. north of Sanandaj. Perennial to 1 m. tall. Yellow flowers, no petals. Raceme flat, very sparse narrow pinnate leaves alternate around stem. Black rust on lower part of stem. Abundant, not eaten. Wild.
380611. *ACHILLEA* sp.  
230. Kalakan. Plant to 30 cm. tall. Sod former. Yellow flowers, no petals. Basal leaves 2 cm. broad at base, gray pubescent, deeply incised. Most abundant plant in graveyard. Heavily used on sheep driveway. Wild.
380612. *ACHILLEA* sp.  
223. Hajiabad. Rhizomatous perennial to 20 cm. tall, leaves 1 cm. by 2 cm. long, fleshy and finely dissected. Yellow flowers with 1 cm. by 1 cm. yellow petals. Wild.
380613. *ACHILLEA* sp.  
377. Mako, near Iran-Turkey border. Plants to 30 cm. tall. Stems spreading 30 cm. Gray pubescent finely incised fernlike basal foliage. Wild.
380614. *ACHILLEA* sp.  
449. Eight km. east of Gajereh. Perennial, slow sodder. Yellow blooms, few petals. Minute, fleshy leaves. Elevation 1,500 m. Abundant on rocky south slope. Wild.
380615. *AELUROPUS LITTORALIS* (Gouan) Parl. Gramineae.  
249. Valadabad, 41 km. south of Gazuin. Perennial to 20 cm. tall. Sod former. Brittle stems and foliage. Abundant in low places in salty areas. Wild.
380616. *AELUROPUS REPENS* (Desf.) Parl.  
141. Ten km. south of Sabzevar. Creeping plant to 16 cm. tall. Poor seed set. In low, moist areas. Wild.
- 380617 to 380619. *AGROPYRON CRISTATUM* (L.) Gaertn. Gramineae.  
**Crested wheatgrass.**
380617. 374. East of Customs House, Mako, Iran-Turkey border. Lime stone shallow soil on hillside. East exposure. Bulk collection, variable types. Wild.
380618. 380. Thirty km. west of Khoy. Vigorous plants, broad heads. Limestone soil. Growing in association with *A. trichophorum*. Wild.
380619. 496. Dryland Experiment Station, Homand, 50 km. east of Tehran. Rainfall 250 m., silty clay gravelly loam. Nursery No. 1025. Elevation 1,900 m. Cultivated.
380620. *AGROPYRON DASYSTACHYUM* (Hook.) Scribn.  
471. Dryland Experiment Station, Homand, 50 km. east of Tehran. Rainfall 250 m., silty clay gravelly loam. Nursery No. 1366. Elevation 1,900 m. Originally from United States. Cultivated.
