381316. S82. 'Cedera Select'. Introduced from Rhodesia. Slightly susceptible to unidentified leaf spot and smut *Ustilago syntherismae*. Self thatching when frosted.

381317. S85. 'Cedera Special'. Introduced from East Africa to the Rietondale Station.

381318. S87. Located originally in the de Hoek Nursery, Estcourt Research Station.

381319. Undetermined Leguminosae.

From Kenya. Seed collected by S. W. Braverman, Officer-in-Charge, East African Plant Quarantine Station, Nairobi. Received July 20, 1973.

Summit of Ol Donyo Sapuk 26 km. southwest of Thika. Plant semiprostrate, 0.5 to 0.7 m. in length. Pods borne in whorls at apex, pubescent, 4 to 5 cm. Elevation 2,145 m. Wild.
