Wild plant with local name Chiltipen. Reported high level of resistance to tobacco etch virus.

**381627. WEIGELA FLORIDA (Bunge) A. DC. Caprifoliaceae.**

From United States. Seedling selected by J. L. Weigle and A. R. Beck, Department of Horticulture, Iowa State University, Ames, Iowa. Received July 24, 1973.

'Pink Princess'. Bush of moderate vigor, 1.5 m. by 1.5 m. in Iowa. Open appearance, unbranched except for short side shoots, stems red when young. Leaves medium large, sometimes becoming purple in the fall. Flowers bright pink (near lilac on RHS color chart) produced in late spring, secondary flowering in July-August on side-branch growths.
