- 383887.** WB 15. National Seashore Park, Ocean Springs, Jackson County, Mississippi. Perennial plant with blue flowers, large broad leaves. Low, wet area near park headquarters buildings. Wild. Plants and seed.
- 383888.** WB 16. Ocean Springs, Jackson County, Mississippi. East 4.8 km. on U.S. Highway 90, both sides of highway for 1.6 km. to 3.2 km. Plant with blue flowers, narrow, linear leaves. Late, heads mostly green. Found in roadside ditches, wet, boggy areas. Wild. Seed.
- 383889.** WB 17. Biloxi, Harrison County, Mississippi. North on Mississippi Highway 15 at junction of Mississippi Highway 15 and 67, and northwest of this junction 5.3 km. on Highway 67. Perennial with blue flowers. Wild. Seed.
- 383890.** WB 18. National Aeronautics and Space Administration Test Center, Picayune, Hancock County. Single plant selection with white flowers, small heads. In ditch along infrequently traveled road. Wild. Plants.
- 383891.** WB 19. National Aeronautics and Space Administration Test Center, Picayune, Hancock County, Mississippi. Plant with blue flowers, late. Abundant in low wet ditch along back road. Wild. Seed.
- 383892.** WB 20. Poplarville, Pearl River County, Mississippi. On Mississippi Highway 26, 6 km. west of intersection U.S. Highway 11 and Mississippi Highway 26. Perennial plant with blue flowers. Abundant on low, mowed roadside area on north side of highway. Wild. Plants.
- 383893.** WB 21A. Purvis, Lamar County, Mississippi. On U.S. Highway 11, south 7.2 km. from intersection of U.S. Highway 11 and Mississippi Highway 587. North of Little Black Creek. Perennial with blue flowers. Abundant along highway right-of-way. Wild. Seed.
- 383894.** WB 21B. Purvis, Lamar County, Mississippi. On U.S. Highway 11, south 8.8 km. from intersection of U.S. Highway 11 and Mississippi Highway 587. South 0.5 km. of Little Black Creek. Perennial with blue flowers. Abundant along highway right-of-way. Wild. Seed.
- 383895.** WB 22. Hattiesburg, Lamar County, Mississippi. South of Hattiesburg on U.S. Highway 11, immediately north of Big Black Creek. Perennial plant with blue flowers. Sparse along west side of highway right-of-way. Wild. Plants and seed.
