

**402588 to 402594. LESPEDEZA CAPITATA Michx. Leguminosae. Roundhead lespedeza.**

From United States. Seed collected October–November 1968 by W. H. Lounsberry, Colo, Iowa, from native stands. Reproduced by Regional Plant Introduction Station, Ames, Iowa. Received March 13, 1975.

**402588.** A-1233. On northeast corner of intersection, 1.6 km east of Riceville on Highway 9 at Four Corners, Howard County. Plants tall, to 91 cm. Heads are more branched and plants taller than P.I. 358326. Seeds from few plants. Wild.

**402589.** A-1234. Along railroad right-of-way, 11 km north of Nashua on curve. Seeds from many plants. Wild.

**402590.** A-1235. Story County, 1.6 km east of McCallsburg along railroad right-of-way. Seed heads are set on tip of main stem in compact bunches or clusters. Few occur below top few inches of stem. Branching among plants varies from slight to considerable. Seed from few plants. Wild.

**402591.** A-1236. Story County, 3.2 km west of McCallsburg, along railroad right-of-way. Just east of intersection on south side of road. Plants medium-tall, single heads. Slight branching stem. Seed from few plants. Wild.

**402592.** A-1239. Native prairie area behind Ames High School, Story County. Same location as for P.I. 287118. Plants tall, profusely branched with good head formation. Stand is dense and plants are vigorous. Wild.

**402593.** A-1352. Collected September 1970, 1.6 km west of McCallsburg along railroad right-of-way, south side on knoll, east of culvert and drainage ditch. Seed from two plants having good branching, medium height, and good standability. Wild.

**402594.** A-1355. Jasper County, Collected 3.2 km north of Colfax on west side of road, south of east turn on Highway 217 when traveling south from Mingo. A strong branching type with unusually strong main stem. Branching begins 30 to 35 cm above ground. Makes good seed set. Wild.

**402595. ARACHIS HYPOGAEA L. Leguminosae. Peanut.**

From Argentina. Seed collected by D. E. McCloud, Department of Agronomy, University of Florida, Gainesville, Florida. Received February 3, 1975.

'Blanco Rio Segundo'. Manfredi area. Cultivated.

From Philippines. Seed presented by International Rice Research Institute, Los Banos, Laguna. Grown at El Centro, California in 1970. Received August 4, 1975.
