with reddish-brown petal spot. Most capsules green or already shattered. This species is common in low, swampy areas around Thika. Growing in stream valley in the midst of rank grass and shrubs. Wild.

405055. HIBISCUS DIVERSIFOLIUS var. WITTEANUS Hochst.

75-131. On Highway A-104, Nakuru-Eldoret Road, 50 km from Nakuru, Km 207 from Nairobi, Nakuru District. Much-branched perennial shrub to 2 m tall, in clumps sometimes 7 to 8 m in circumference. Spiny stems, bristly calyces. Pale yellow flowers with dark red petal spot. Good size population of plants growing streamside with *Typha* and shrubs. Wild.

405056 to 405058. HIBISCUS GREENWAYI E. G. Baker

405056. 75-140. On Highway A-109, Mombasa Highway, 8 km east of MacKinnon Road, Kwale District. Upright, thick-stemmed, perennial to 3 m tall. Flowers primrose with dark red petal spot. Pendulous stems with large, recurved red spines. Growing in dense thicket of small trees, shrubs, *Sansevieria*, *Aloe*, *Euphorbia*. Wild.

405057. 75-143. On Highway A-109, Nairobi-Mombasa Road, 30 km west of Mombasa, Kwale District. Thick-stemmed perennial to 2 m tall. Primrose flowers with dark red petal spot. Pendulous, funnellform, do not stay open at any time of the day. Stems with large red spines. Growing at edge of ditch with grasses and shrubs. Wild.

405058. 75-149. On Highway A-109, Nairobi-Mombasa Road, 32 km west of Mombasa, Kwale District. Much-branched perennial to 4 m tall. Primrose flowers with dark red petal spot, pendulous, funnellform. Main trunk to 5 cm in diameter, lateral branches to 2 cm in diameter. Stems with large spines. Only a few ripe capsules. Plants appear to be old and well established. Growing in association with *Lantana* and *Opuntia* species. Wild.

405059. HIBISCUS VITIFOLIUS L.

75-144. On Highway A-109, Nairobi-Mombasa Road, 30 km west of Mombasa, Kwale District. Bushy perennial to 2 m tall. Flowers light pink. Growing with grasses and shrubs. Wild.

405060. OCIMUM KILIMANDSCHARICUM Gurcke Lamiaceae. Hairy basil.

75-153. On Highway A-109, 30 km west of Mombasa, Kwale District. Odorous, semiwoody shrub to 60 cm tall, with white flowers. Growing on roadside with grasses and shrubs. Wild.

405061 and 405062. OCIMUM SUAVE Willd. Basil.

405061. 75-151. On Highway A-3, Thika-Carissa Road, 22 km east of Thika, Kiambu District. Odorous, semiwoody shrub to 1 m tall. In fruit, no open flowers seen. Growing in dry scrub. Wild.

405062. 75-152. Thika River, Chania Falls, Kismbu District. Odorous, semiwoody shrub to 1 m tall. No open flowers seen. Growing on roadside with grass and shrubs. Wild.

405063. GLYCYRRHIZA GLABRA L. Fabaceae. Common licorice.
